When you understand your tumor's biomarkers and treatment options, you can make clear and confident decisions about your next steps.

To ensure you are making informed choices, consider asking yourself key questions. If you find that you cannot answer them, it's important to discuss those topics with your doctor.

- Do I understand my diagnosis?
- Is my tumor classified according to the latest guidelines?
- Do I know my tumor's biomarkers and how they impact my prognosis and treatment options?
- Am I fully aware of all treatment options available to me at this time?
- Will any of my treatment options impact future clinical trial eligibility?
- Am I aware of the potential risks, benefits, and side effects of each treatment option?
- Have I considered what is most important to me?
- What are my goals of care?
- Does my decision align with my values and lifestyle?
- Am I feeling prepared for what to expect with my diagnosis?
- Have I been offered a second opinion or considered seeking one?
- Do I know what questions to ask during my appointments?
- Do I understand what my insurance will cover and what costs I might be responsible for?
